We offer patient home visits to advise on any aspect of illness including emotional support and managing symptoms.

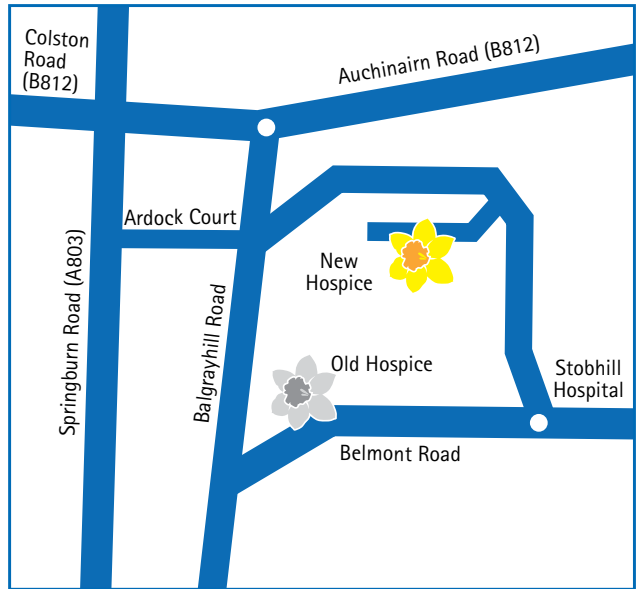
